The Gospel According To God- Acts 2:22-24

Discussion Questions:

- What parts of this message do you feel like you really needed to hear?
- In the message it was mentioned that familiarity with the gospel can lead to becoming unimpressed by its greatness. How can we guard against this and continue to find the gospel awe-inspiring?
- The gospel of Jesus Christ has the power to transform lives just as it did in Peter's life. Have you ever experienced a transformation in your own life as a result of the gospel? If so, can you share your story with the group?
- How does the resurrection of Jesus give us hope and assurance that our sins are forgiven and that we will also experience resurrection and eternal life?
- In what ways does the historical fact of Jesus' bodily resurrection strengthen the credibility of Christianity as a faith and give us confidence in the truth of the Gospel?
- How can we live our lives with a greater understanding of the significance of the resurrection of Jesus and the victory over death that it represents for all believers?
