What Did We Learn From the Book of Habakkuk?

1. It is okay to struggle with doubt and ask God honest questions

- 2. God is often doing His most profound work when it looks like He is doing nothing
- 3. When it comes to difficult circumstances God doesn't need your help, He wants your trust
 - 4. Remember the importance of perspective (its imperative that yours be accurate)
 - 5. You won't see what God is doing unless you are willing to wait on Him
 - 6. God will sometimes use ungodly agents to reprove or correct His children
- 7. God is sovereign; He can use whomever and whatever He pleases to accomplish His will and purposes
 - 8. God confronts us when we forget Him in our successes
 - 9. Having occasional doubts and honest questions doesn't make you a bad Christian
 - 10. In a crisis of faith choose to embrace God rather than move away from Him
 - 11. Choosing faith in the midst of difficulties changes everything!
- 12. Keep yourself free from greed (it always leads to a reversal of fortune and self-destruction)
 - 13. Be content with what you have (covetousness always leads to emptiness and regrets)
- 14. Guard your purity (immorality always leads to shame; and what you've done to others ends up coming back on you)
 - 15. Avoid idolatry in all its forms (it always brings divine judgment)
 - 16. If you want your faith to go from troubled to triumphant:
 Request of the Lord through prayer
 Remember His past deeds
 Rest in Him while you are waiting patiently
 Rejoice in Him by faith
 Rely on His strength in the meantime
