An indispensable tool for the Berry Patch. You need a good strong stick of some kind. I have the handle from an old garden hoe. It works really well. So just why do we need that stick? There are a couple of reasons:

- You can use it to poke around as you walk through the patch. I poke around on the path I am walking to warn the snakes that I am coming. If you find yourself in confrontation with a snake, it makes a good weapon.
- 2. It helps you keep from tripping if one of those tough vines gets wrapped around your boots.
- 3. You need it because the Berry Patch keeps secrets. We will talk about that one in a later lesson.

Today, let's talk about reason #1 from the list.

This snake was one of those. He coiled into position to strike, with that "cotton mouth" wide open.

Now I am usually a live-and-let-live guy when it comes to snakes of any kind, but this one was too close to where my grandkids roam around in the pasture, so I decided to do away with him.

I pulled out my trusty pistol, fired five or six shots at him and missed him every time. There was a 6' long piece of a wooden branch nearby that had fallen out of one of the trees. I picked up the branch and smacked him with it and it was over. So basically I just whopped him with that stick.

You don't have to be really afraid of anything you can kill with a stick.

In the Bible we read that our enemy, satan is called a snake. Satan is a formidable enemy for sure but he has been defeated by Jesus. And what did Jesus use to defeat satan? Yep, a big stick. A stick called the Cross. The devil threw everything he had at Jesus, he was never even close to being a match for Jesus. So why did Jesus die on that "big stick?"
