

Unshaken Truth in a Shifting World

David H. Davenport – Psalm 93

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I. God's Throne Is Eternal — and So Is His Truth Psalm 93:1–2, 5; Malachi 3:6

- God's reign is not seasonal — it is eternal.
- His testimonies are completely reliable.
- Holiness still adorns His house.
- Because God does not change, His mercy endures.

II. Satan's Strategy: Spoil the design Isaiah 14:12–15; Revelation 12:7–12

- Satan's rebellion was rooted in pride.
- He works to Spoil what God created.
- Believers overcome him by the blood of the Lamb and the word of their testimony.

III. God's First Command Was Life and Fruitful ^{was} Genesis 1:27–28

- God's design was life — generative, relational, and sacred.
- Anything that thwarts life or distorts it is not from Him.

IV. Jesus Didn't Erase the Law — He Fulfilled It Matthew 5:17–18

- Jesus affirms the continuity of God's Word.
- He didn't loosen the law — He deepened it.

V. Jesus Deepens the Law — It's About the Heart Matthew 5:21–48

- Sin isn't just action — it's intention.
- Jesus raises the bar from external behavior to internal transformation.
- Holiness begins in the heart.

VI. Paul's Letters: Correction, Not Contradiction Corinthians 5:1–2

- Paul didn't invent doctrine — he corrected rebellion.
- His letters apply Jesus' teachings to real-world messiness.

VII. Grace Doesn't Erase Holiness — It Empowers It Romans 6:1–2

- Grace is not a loophole — it's a lifeline.
- It empowers obedience and writes the law on our hearts.

VIII. We Are God's House — Holiness Still Adorns It 1 Peter 2:5

- We are God's house — and holiness still adorns it.
- Let our lives reflect His design, not the culture's confusion.

IX. Return to the Lord — He Still Receives Malachi 3:7; James 4:8; Luke 15:20

- God's holiness is not a barrier — it's a beckoning.
- No matter how far we've wandered, the invitation to return still stands.
- The prodigal was embraced while still far away.
