Big Idea

God gave you the freedom to choose Him.

The dragon uses coercion — but Christ leads by invitation.

The one who holds the remote has the power.

Key Scriptures

- **John 8:36** "So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed."
- Galatians 5:1 "It is for freedom that Christ has set us free..."
- **Revelation 13:16–17** Coercion and control by the beast.
- **Revelation 14:1** The Lamb with those who freely choose Him.
- **Joshua 24:15** "Choose this day whom you will serve."

How to Guard Your Remote This Week

1. GUARD IT

Don't let fear, culture, politics, or guilt control your choices.

Ask yourself: Who or what is holding my remote today?

2. USE IT

Make daily choices that align with your faith.

Practice flipping the channel: when shame, anger, or anxiety come on—switch to prayer, Scripture, or worship.

3. AIM IT

A remote only works when pointed at the source.

Keep your life aimed at Jesus through prayer, Sabbath rest, and service.

Is it fear, guilt, culture, or Christ?
