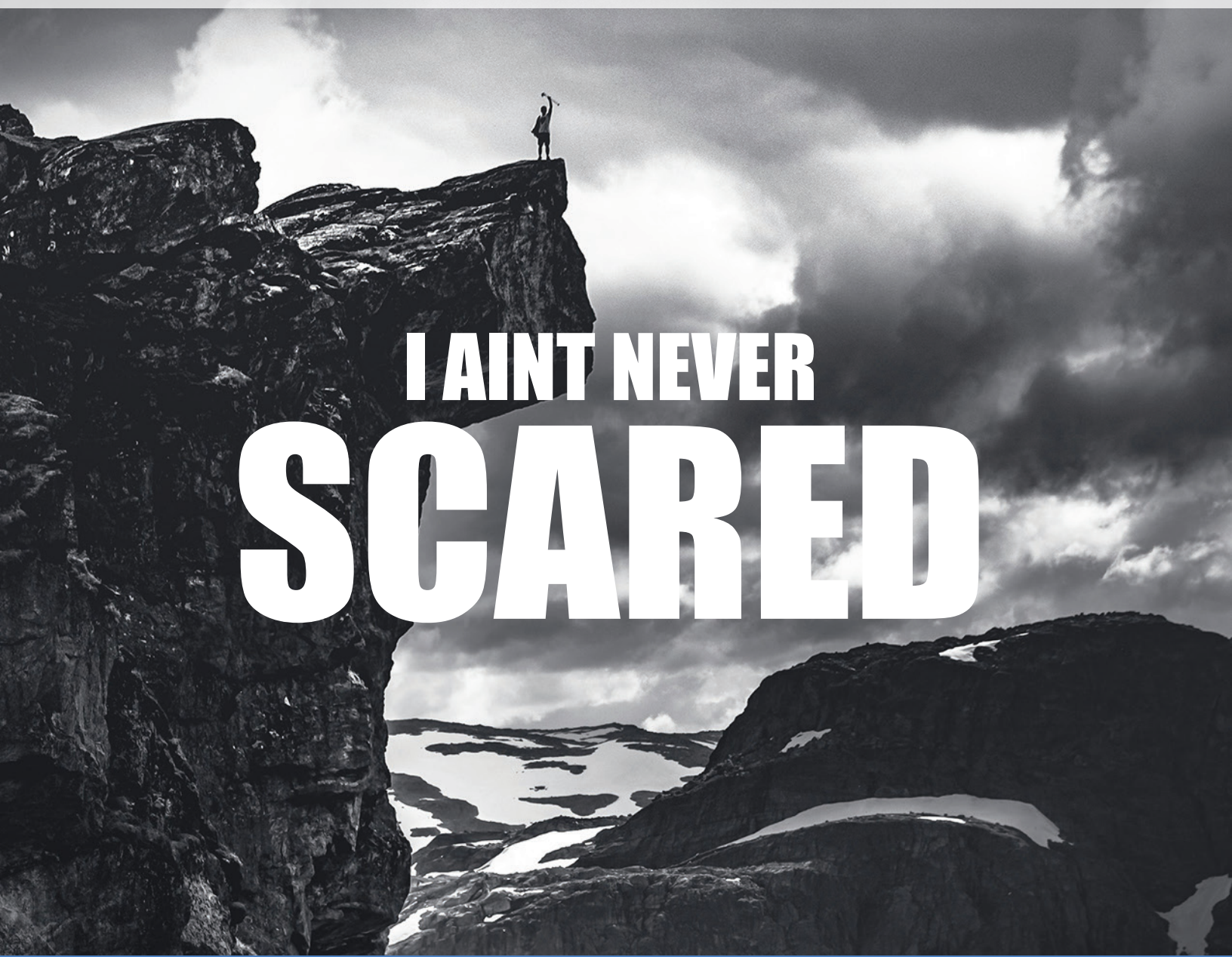

I Ain't Never Scared

Romans 8:31-39

INTRODUCTION

NOTES

Over and over again in Scripture, we are told “Do not fear.” I think the Lord knew how often we would need this reminder considering all that we face during our lives on this earth that could cause us to be afraid. However, because we have a relationship with Almighty God, we don’t have to fear, because He has made us more than conquerors. In today’s key text, we are given advice on how to approach life with fearless faith. Let’s dive in together.

KEY POINTS

1. Realize that God is on our side.

Paul says that whatever is bothering you, worrying you, threatening you, or overwhelming you, we have to realize that if God is for us, it does not matter who is against us. In other words, what Paul is saying is that who's on your team is all that matters. When God is on your side, you don't have to worry or fear. He's going to take care of you. He's going to watch over you. And He's going to help you.

2. We're in a fixed fight.

The point Paul is making in today's key passage is that when we encounter an opposition, an adversary, or an enemy, the outcome has been fixed and our victory has already been predetermined. We are on the winning team as followers of Jesus. Even if times are tough now, we can rest assured that it won't be like this forever. Jesus will be victorious in the end, which means that as His followers, we will be victorious as well.

3. Our stance is solid.

Because God is on our side and because the fight is fixed, our stance is firm. Paul closes this passage with a declaration of boldness and confidence in the fact of life's trial that has inspired generations of believers to this day. He says that because God is on our side and because the fight is fixed, there is nothing—no problem, no adversary, no force, no power, no person, no situation, nor is there any challenge that can separate us from the love of God. That's a solid stance.
