INTRODUCTION	NOTES
Does life have you down and discouraged? Are you anxious or worried about how your current circumstances are going to play out? If so, I want you to know something today; Your problems, no matter how great, cannot cancel God's promise. Your problems cannot nullify His purpose and plans for your life. What God has in store for you is still possible because with Him all things are possible! In today's message, we are going to look more closely at that truth and unpack three ways you'll know God can make all things possible.	
KEY POINTS	
1. You Know It's Still Possible When You Realize You Have Favor On Your Life The Bible says so much about favor, which is God's unmerited kindness. Favor is when God steps into our lives to make an unimaginable, inexplicable difference in our lives. And you know you're favored because, as a follower of Jesus, you've got God's presence. Favor is not as many claimreducible to or just about material prosperity, nor does it mean that trials won't come your way.	
What it does mean is that God is on your side, and because of that, His presence bestows outcomes and benefits that you would not have on your own.	
The reason that you can have hope and peace is in the assurance that not only are God's promises still possible (they are), or that His Word is still true (it is), but that you are blessed and highly favored by your Heavenly Father.	
2. You Know It's Still Possible When The Father Does The Unexpected It is easy to get angry or to lose hope and give up while waiting for God to come through for you on a promise. There are times when we even can feel rejected by God when He doesn't seem to be answering us or acknowledging our prayers. But remember that special orders take time.

It's like being asked to pull over at the drive-thru at McDonald's when you want your burger without onion. It's taking more time because they're preparing something special. God is preparing something special, and it may be taking a long time, but it is on the way. His methods and His timing might be unexpected, but that doesn't mean it's not possible for God to come through.

3. You Know It's Still Possible When You've Got Faith For The Unseen

Mary says in Luke 1:38, "Let it be to me according to your word." In other words, Mary says, "I may not understand how, but I'm standing on a Word God gave me." Mary shows us it can still happen when you stand on His Word. It's God's word that makes the impossible possible.

She's not pregnant yet, she's not showing yet, she's not having contractions yet...but she saying by faith, "it's already done." And God is looking for us to stand and say, "I may not have it yet, but I believe it's already done!" Remember, we walk by faith and not by sight. As people of faith, we see it by faith before we see it with our eyes. I know you don't see things turning around yet, but it's just a matter of time.
