Repentance is:

1. Metanoia = “change of mind”, describing a fundamental, radical transformation of one’s thinking, attitude, and direction.
2. Not just a one-time event, but an ongoing posture of turning from sin and trusting in Christ.
3. A shift in attitude toward Jesus’
4. Closely related to faith.
5. Demonstrated by actions.
6. A gift. (*Acts 5:31; Acts 11:18; 2 Timothy 2:25; Acts 3:26*)

Godly Grief

- Grieves that God has been dishonored.
- Makes use of grace to sin no longer.
- Lays hold of Jesus Christ and the gospel.
- Trusts Jesus that the penalty for sin was paid at the cross.
- Concerned with what God thinks.
- Concerned with what others think about God.
- Produces repentance.

Worldly Grief

- Grieves the consequences of sin, not the dishonor to God.
- Makes me sad for a season, but doesn’t bring change.
- Continues in self-absorption, self-pity, and self rule.
- Rejects grace.
- Concerned with what people think.
- Concerned with what others think of me.
- Produces despair and death.
