SERMON NOTES

Foolish Boasting | September 6, 2026
2 Corinthians 11:16-33 | Pastor Andy Duke

BIG IDEA: If Paul must boast, he will boast in his weakness, that the grace and power of Christ may rest upon him.

1. Why boast? (vv. 16-21).

2. Boasting “as a fool” is pride in our own

strength (vv. 22-23a; 1 Cor. 4:7; Jas. 1:17).

As Christians *trust* God in the midst of their suffering, it:

(1) Puts the real gospel on display (Col. 1:24)

(2) Makes His people more like His Son

(Heb. 5:8; Rom. 5:3-5; Phil. 2:5, 8)

(3) Reveals what true glory looks like (Phil. 3:8)

3. Boasting in weakness produces inexpressible joy in Christ's grace and power

(vv. 23b-33; 12:9; Acts 9:15-16).
