“Therefore, let all of us who are mature think this way. And if you think differently about anything, God will reveal this also to you. In any case, we should live up to whatever truth we have attained.”

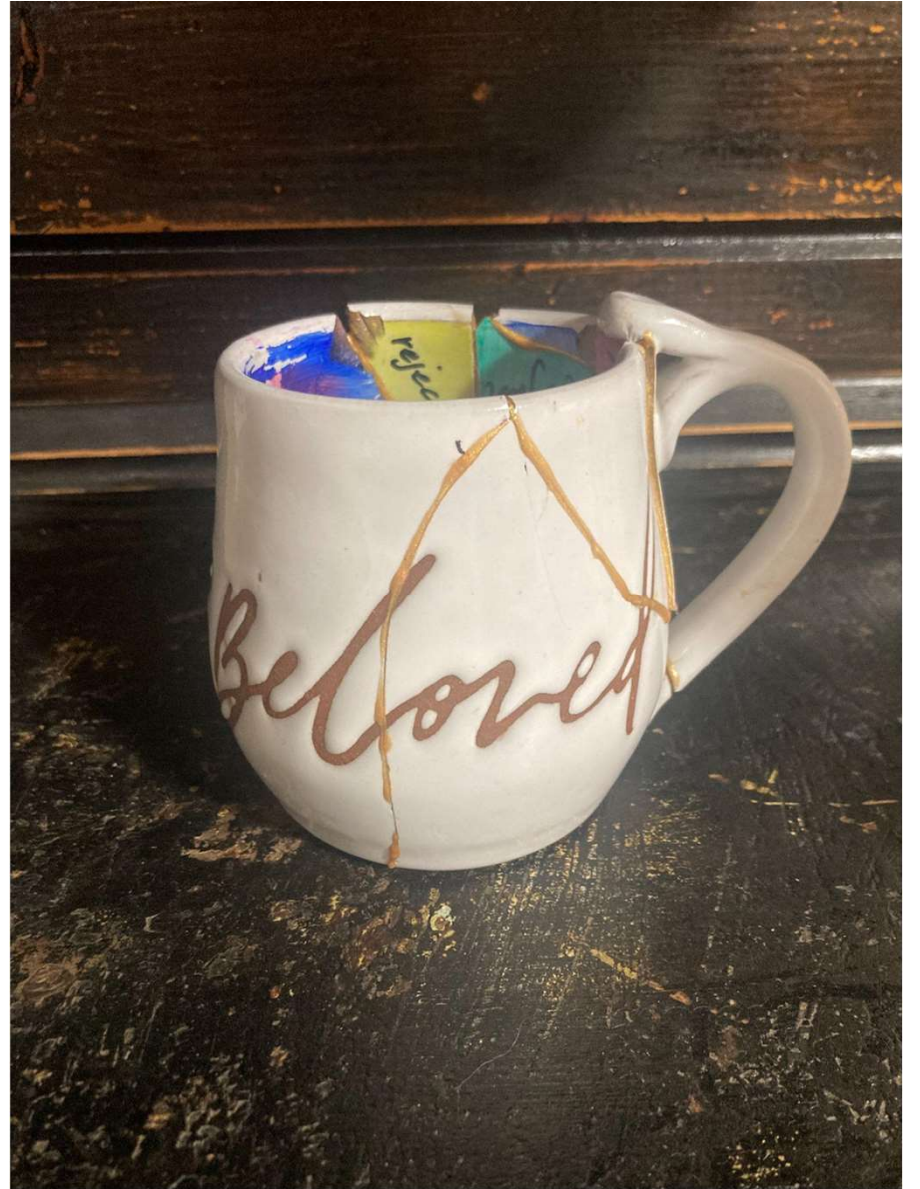
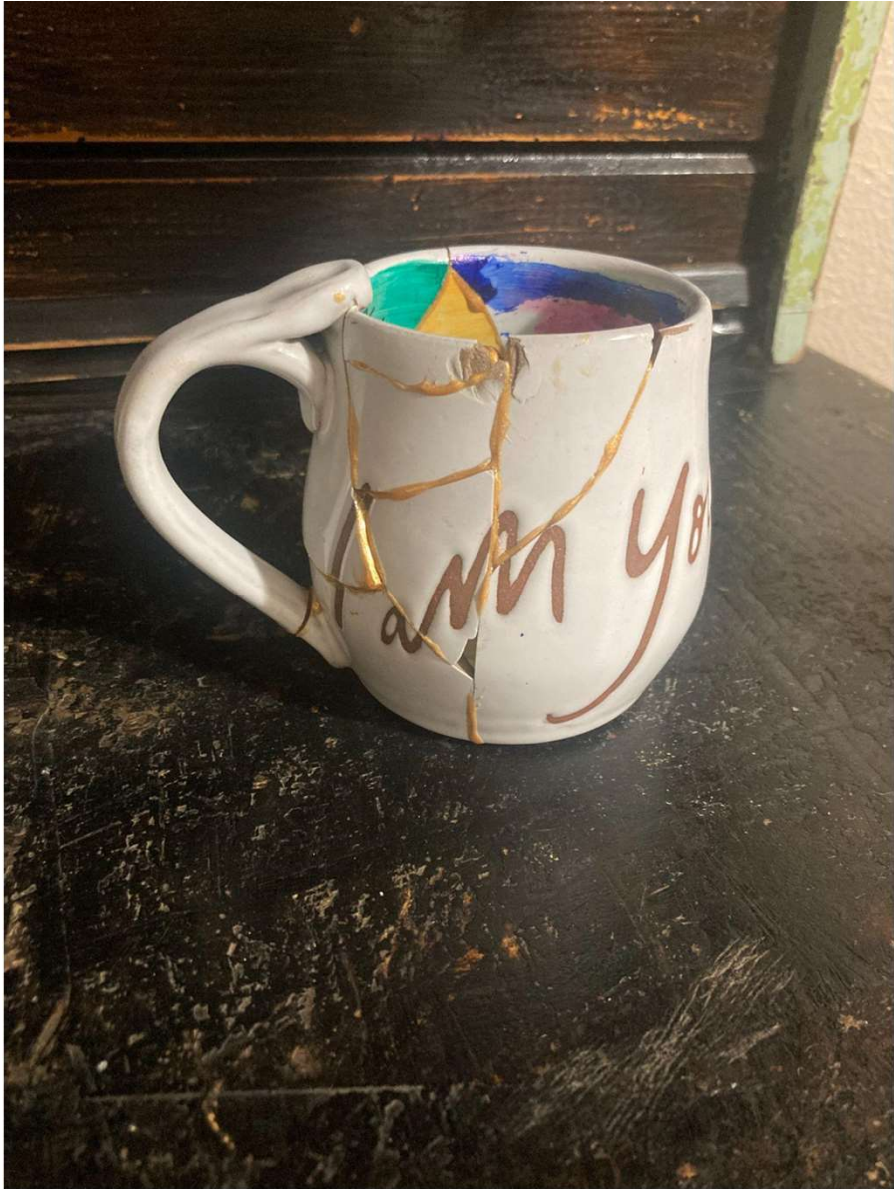
2 Peter 1:2-10

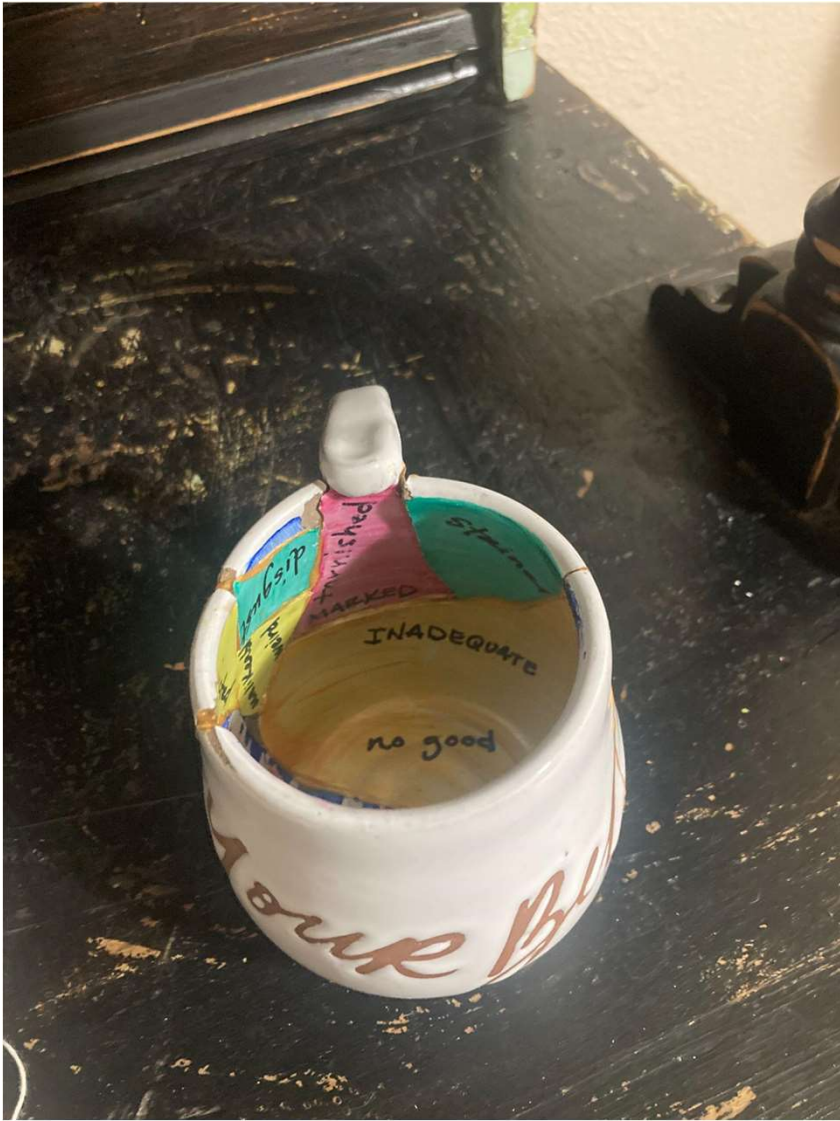

Shame is like an infection that harms and affects our emotions, behaviors, actions, perspectives and relationship towards others. Shame is an overwhelming sense of anguish, sorrow, and remorse that terrorizes individuals with even more shame for feeling shame. It can be felt deep in ones' bones, stealing our belovedness.

Experiencing shame makes one feel vulnerable, exposed, ashamed, or the feeling of being horrified about something.

The grace of knowing God and being known by God, brings light and we become like Jesus and mature to be who we were created to be. His grace is like a healing balm to our feelings of unworthiness and unacceptableness. It reclaims our lost inner child and returns us to His heart as

He guides us to the place or calling for which He created us.

Resilience is the ability to exercise courage, vulnerability, compassion, awareness, and connectedness to oneself, others, and God. Resilience is our ability to stand in our freedom, our identity, and our belovedness in the face of adversity or the enemy's tactics to derail us.

He has inaugurated for us a new and living way through the curtain (that is, through his flesh) and since we have a great high priest over the house of God, let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed in pure water. Let us hold on to the confession of our hope without wavering, since he who

promised is faithful. And let us consider one another in order to provoke love and good works, not neglecting to gather together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging each other, and all the more as you see the day approaching.”

Remember the earlier days when, after you had been enlightened, you endured a hard struggle with sufferings. Sometimes you were publicly exposed to taunts and afflictions, and at other times you were companions of those who were treated that way. For you sympathized with the prisoners and accepted with joy the confiscation of your possessions, because

you know that you yourselves have a better and enduring possession. So don't throw away your confidence, which has a great reward. For you need endurance, so that after you have done God's will, you may receive what was promised. For yet in a very little while, the Coming One will come and not delay. But my righteous one will live by faith; and if he draws back I have no

pleasure in him. But we are not those who draw back and are destroyed, but those who have faith and are saved.”
