Table Talk

The sermon today was on Jesus being God from John 1:1. In the Table Talk for this week we will focus upon John 14:6 and John 10:9-10

WARM UP: What is the hardest question you have ever been asked and why?

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

The Way: The words "the way" can mean a path or direction, or a particular method of doing things. The concept has to do with action, not just belief. (James 1:22).

The Truth: The Truth is not "my truth" or "your truth," relative to our experience. The Truth is absolute and true for all. We're called to love the Truth and hold fast to it. (2 Thessalonians 2:10-13).

The Life: Jesus calls us to seek after the life He promises. Even if we have to give up other things, it will be worth it. (Matthew 7:14, 16:25-26)

Q1- The most important question you will ever answer is this, Who Is Jesus Christ to you? Why is this such an important question? (Review John 14:6)

Q2-Tell about a time when you were forced to choose between God's way and your way? What did you choose? How did that work out?

Q3-How do you understand the difference between things that are sometimes true or true for certain people (relative truth) and things that are always true for everyone (absolute truth)?

Q4-In John 10:10, Jesus says: "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly." What do you think Jesus meant by "life abundantly?" Is he talking about material things or spiritual things? Or both?

Q5-How are the way, the truth, and the life related? How do these three ideas interconnect in your experience of following Jesus?
