Table Talk

This sermon was biographical sermon on the man Titus. One of the noteworthy character traits in his life was DEPENDABILITY. This lesson is aimed at helping you grow in the character of dependability.

Warm Up: How important to you is dependability?

Dependable is being consistently reliable and trustworthy. It will allow us to continue in our commitments even if it means personal sacrifice. This will allow others to build trust in us and point to the One who they can put the most important trust in, Christ as Lord.

- John 15:13 Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends.
- 1 Corinthians 4:2 Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found faithful.
- Colossians 1:10 so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

Unreliable and unpredictable are the opposites of dependable. This can range from constantly being late and holding others up, to having a personality that is unpredictable that others do not know how to relate and respond to you.

Here are positive examples from Scripture (Gen. 6:5-8; 7:1-5; Ruth 1:15-18; Matt. 24:42-25:13; Phil. 2:19-23)

Here are negative examples from Scripture (2 Sam. 3:26-30; 39; Matt. 25:21-30; 2 Tim. 4:9-11)

Now ask yourself:

- How do I exhibit dependability in my daily life?
- What are the things that cause you to be unreliable?
- What can I do to develop a better attitude of being dependable?
- What stressors are in my life would improve with me being more dependable?
