## **2 Timothy 3:14-17**

***“But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.”***

### EXPLAIN - WHAT DOES THE TEXT MEAN?

- What does the passage say about God?
- What does it say about people and their need for God?
- What does it say about sin?
- What do the words mean?

### APPLY - HOW DOES THE TEXT IMPACT ME?

- Is there a command to obey?
- Is there a promise to claim?

### RESPOND - HOW WILL I RESPOND TO THE TEXT?

- Does the passage instruct me about how I should live? If so, how?
- We can know what God values in his word, but it's just academic if we don't respond to what God is revealing to us.
