Table Talk

Warm Up: What is something that you are very willing to share with others?

- 1. What does the angel's command (after freeing the Apostles) tell us about God's mission priorities? (v. 20)
- 2. The Apostles go right back to teaching, even though they were just imprisoned for it.
 - How does this encourage you to be a bold witness for Jesus despite any opposition you might face?
- 3. Peter and the apostles respond to the religious leaders with this powerful quote, "We must obey God rather than men" (v. 29).
 - What does this suggest about how we can summon boldness in the face of opposition?
 - What does this teach us about when it is appropriate for a Christian to disobey authorities?
- 4. In your own words, how would you summarize Gamaliel's warning to the Sanhedrin in verses (35-39)?
 - How does his warning highlight the uniqueness of Jesus and the Resurrection?
 - How does this encourage you in your faith as you consider the endurance of the gospel for more than 20 centuries after these words were spoken?
- 5. What sustained the Apostles in staying faithful and bold, despite threats, beatings, and imprisonment? (40-42)
 - What fuels your faith and keeps you going when things get tough?
 - How can you deepen your resolve to follow Jesus as the cost of following Him increases?

Closing Prayer: Father God empower me through the ministry of the Holy Spirit to testify to others this week that you are the Christ, the RESCUER of my soul. Help me to make much of YOU!
