
Introduction: Text: Mark 4:1-20

The message Jesus taught (4:1)
The parables Jesus used to teach (4:2)
The parables of Jesus were memorable stories intended to provoke Kingdom learning and living.
Jesus' teaching required the hearers to possess spiritual openness and mental diligence.
The same teaching of Jesus can cause the repentant to receive more and the rebellious to resist more.
 The mission Jesus assigned was to proclaim a message of(3:14; 6:12)
Essentially, the Bible defines sin as anproblem, a conflict over the issue of control
 My kingdom vs. God's Kingdom
 This is the problem the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ was designed to solve!
Sin is a kingdom issue
 As a Kingdom issue it inevitably produces animosity, hostility, and conflict toward God.
The crucifixion of Jesus demonstrates how far human beings will go to protect and
preserve their kingdoms.
