Table Talk

Warm Up: Is there a story behind your given name? If so, maybe share it with the group.

1. In the sermon, we learned that the “angel of the LORD” who appeared in the burning bush in Exodus 3 was a preincarnate (before incarnation) of Christ. Jesus declared Himself to be existent “before Abraham” (John 8:58), so it makes sense that He would be active and could manifest in the world. Discuss the significance of this appearance to Moses.
2. Moses asks God in Exodus 3:11, “Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh to bring the Israelites out of Egypt?” In response, God does not give Moses a “pep talk” and remind him that he is prepared and capable for this task. What is God’s response to Moses’ question (read Exodus 3:12)? How can you remind yourself of this truth throughout the week?
3. Moses struggled with God’s request to lead the Israelites (Exodus 3:10-12). Why does God choose unlikely people to get involved in his work and do his will? Do you ever feel inadequate to do what God wants you to do? How does this promise encourage you?
4. In Exodus 3:14, God says to Moses, “I AM WHO I AM” meaning that God is consistent; His character does not vary with situations or circumstances. What about this truth brings you comfort?
5. Read through the Truth into Action steps and discuss the next steps you can take in your walk with Jesus based upon them.

Closing Prayer: Thank you for Exodus 3 and what I have learned about You. Please remind me that **to know I am not BUT TO KNOW the great I AM** is the key to understanding myself and life. In Jesus sweet name. Amen!
