1. If (when) you don't know what to do, ask God. (v 5)		
Wisdom is the practical use of knowledge in every day decision making.		
Solomon tells us that is the first step in gaining wisdom (Proverbs 1:7)

2. Approach God with complete confidence that He will answer. (v. 6)		
We don't pray to a God of chance and happenstance—We pray to the sovereign creator and sustainer of the universe,Him to act on our behalf.		
Doubt exists when we call into question the character of the object of our faith. Therefore, doubting is an on the very of God. But James' point is that doubt calls into question our character.		
Doubt weakens us and leaves us to all sorts of worthless ideas.		
3. Doubt disqualifies us from receiving the answer we desire. (v. 7)		
A doubting believer chooses to live like an, refusing to act in trusting obedience to the goodness of God.
