

# God's Epic Story of Rescue

May 3, 2026

**Bible Passage:** Exodus 12-13

**Big Idea:** In the Passover, The LORD (Yahweh) reveals THE WAY OUT that He desires for each of \_\_\_\_\_ in our \_\_\_\_\_.

**#1- Yahweh \_\_\_\_\_ His people from \_\_\_\_\_ (12:21-28)**

- The rescue from judgement would come through the \_\_\_\_\_.
- Yahweh instructed them to “\_\_\_\_\_” or care for the lamb from the 10<sup>th</sup> to the 14<sup>th</sup> -----**WHY?**
  - **Yahweh’s plan included the \_\_\_\_\_ with the lamb’s sacrifice and their deliverance.**
- Yahweh would “pass over” [pasakh or \_\_\_\_\_] the door and not allow the destroyer to enter.

**#2-Yahweh \_\_\_\_\_ His people from the \_\_\_\_\_ (12:29-36)**

**#3- Yahweh \_\_\_\_\_ His people to \_\_\_\_\_ (13:5-10, 11-16)**

- There are three things the LORD wants them to remember:
  - the *release from captivity* (12:26-27)
  - the *meager provisions* (13:5-10)
  - the *sparing of the firstborn* (13:11-16)
- Remember it was with a “strong hand the LORD brought you out” of Egypt. (Exodus 13:3,14-15)

**#4- Yahweh \_\_\_\_\_ His people all the way \_\_\_\_\_ (13:21-22)**

- Yahweh doesn’t simply release them from slavery and leave them to figure it out on their own from here.
- Yahweh leads them from the place of captivity to a “promised land” that He has for them.
- Exodus 13:21-22

## Truth Into Action:

- You can be spared from judgement if you look to Jesus. **TURN TO JESUS CHRIST!**
- You can be set free from slavery and live daily secure & overflowing with hope of eternal life. **LIVE YOUR LIFE WITH HOPE IN JESUS CHRIST!**
- Remembering what Yahweh has done in the past defeats the fears of what we still need Him to do in the future. **PROCLAIM THE LORD’S DEATH & EXPECT HIS RETURN.**
- Jesus is preparing a place and He is coming back. **FOLLOW JESUS AND LET HIM LEAD YOU SAFELY HOME.**

## Table Talk:

**This lesson is a follow up to the sermon. Please take the time this week to work through it in your community group or around your own kitchen table.**

**Warm Up: Share a story of a time when you were glad you followed the given instructions.**

1. Read Exodus 12:21-23. Knowing yourself and how you process things, what do you imagine your response would have been to the given instructions to avoid the death of your first born?
2. In the sermon, the point was made that Yahweh wanted the Hebrews to have a connection to the Passover lamb (Read Exodus 12:3,6). Discuss the implications of “keeping” the lamb apart from the rest of the sheep for four days, then killing it.
3. The 4<sup>th</sup> point in the sermon was ***Yahweh leads them all the way home*** anchoring in Exodus 13:21-22). Discuss what it might have been like to have been led in this manner.
  - How does the truth of John 14:1-6 comfort you in how Jesus leads believers all the way home?
4. The Israelites were led by God in a dynamic fashion (Exodus 13:21-22). Some people have verbalized, “Why can’t God lead me right now, like He led the Israelites out of Egypt?” When a person is saved or “born again” (John 3:1-18) they are given the Holy Spirit who now lives within them (Romans 8:9). Read the following verses and discuss how the Holy Spirit leads believers today:
  - John 16:8
  - 2 Timothy 3:16-17
  - John 16:13
  - John 14:26
  - Romans 8:14-16
  - Acts 1:8 & 2 Timothy 1:7
  - 1 Corinthians 6:11
