## #2-How is the Gospel of Mark distinct?

- Audience--Most scholars agree that the gospel of Mark was intended for Gentiles, likely those residing in Rome.
- - Jesus is King over all things (Mark 1-8)
  - o \_\_\_\_\_--Why did Jesus come?
    - Jesus came to die on the cross (Mark 9-16)

## #3-Mark begins with anchoring the Gospel in a PERSON

•	He is truly HUMAN (has a human name)
	<ul> <li>The name "Jesus" means "Jehovah is Salvation"</li> </ul>
•	The title "Christ" identifies Jesus as the "Jewish Messiah", or "the Anointed One"
	<ul> <li>The title "Christ" declares His Position as the DELIVER</li> </ul>
•	of He is truly UNIQUE – He is the Son of God.
	<ul> <li>He is both humanity &amp; deity in one Person.</li> </ul>
