Introduction:
Text: Mark 1:14-20
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Big Idea: Jesus said to a handful of ordinary peopleF M He's still using the same language. What is your response.
#1-The message of Jesus was not ordinary (MARK 1:14-15) • The time is fulfilled: The context and content of Jesus' ministry was precisely predetermined.
• The kingdom of God is at hand: The kingdom of God is about the and of God
 Repent and believe in the gospel: The gospel does not mean good advice, it means a decisive victory has been and that's GOOD NEWS!
#2- Jesus often recruits ordinary people during a busy routine (MARK 1:16-18) • Jesus' mission began with gathering a few unassuming disciples.
Instead of students selecting their desired teacher, Jesus relationships with those He wanted to follow Him.
Jesus fishermen in order to gather and spare people from God's impending judgment.
#3- Jesus will with the plans of ordinary people to make them his disciples (MARK 1:18-20) • is not getting Jesus to help with your agenda but aligning your entire life to fit with your agenda.
The boldness of Jesus' call to discipleship only makes sense if He has the to interrupt our lives.
 Most people try to use Jesus in the three areas that He called the original disciples to surrender:
Truth into Action:

#1-Know that Jesus is the SAFEST LEADER TO FOLLOW.

#2-Believe the Gospel message proclaimed by Jesus?

#3-Ask the question: Does my life look like I believe the gospel?
