Warm Up: Have you ever felt pushed to do something you really didn't want to do? Explain what you mean (note: this can be a positive thing you were pushed to do or a negative thing you were pushed to do)

- 1. Read the following paragraph and record what you learned: The Greek word translated "Comforter" or "Counselor" (as found in John 14:16, 26; 15:26; and 16:7) is *parakletos*. This form of the word is unquestionably passive and properly means "one called to the side of another"; the word carries a secondary notion concerning the purpose of the calling alongside: to counsel or support the one who needs it. This Counselor, or Paraclete, is God the Holy Spirit, the third Person of the Trinity who has been "called to our side." He is a personal being, and He indwells every believer.
