
Devotion 24: Guided All the Way Home

March 21, 2026

Scripture: *Isaiah 42:16 & Psalm 23:6*

*"I will lead the blind in a way that they do not know... I will not forsake them."
(Isaiah 42:16) | "Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life,
and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD forever." (Psalm 23:6)*

Devotion

Every good guide has a destination in mind. They don't lead just to lead. They lead to bring you somewhere. The whole point of a guide is to get you home.

That is the promise woven through all of Scripture. God told Abraham, "Go" — and then guided him to a land and a future more beautiful than Abraham could have imagined. God guided Israel through a barren wilderness — and brought them into a promised land flowing with milk and honey. God guided Joseph through slavery and prison — and brought him to a place where he could save an entire nation. And God sent His own Son, Jesus, into the darkness of our world — and guided Him through the cross to an empty tomb and an ascension into glory.

Every one of those stories is a signpost pointing to the final destination. God is not just guiding us through the ups and downs of this life. He is guiding us home. All the way home — to the house of the Lord forever. The same God who has never once lost someone He was leading, who has never taken a wrong turn, who turns rough places into level ground — that God has promised to walk with you every step of the way and to bring you to the place where there is no more darkness, no more rough terrain, no more getting lost. This is the whole journey of Lent — from sin to grace, from lostness to being led, from the cross to the empty tomb, from here to home.

Discussion Questions

1. Looking back over your life, where can you see that God was guiding you — even in times you felt lost?
2. What does it mean to you personally that God's final destination for you is His house forever?
3. How has this week's devotions changed or encouraged the way you think about following God through hard times?

Closing Prayer

Faithful Guide, thank You for never losing us. Thank You for guiding us through every wilderness, every dark valley, and every hard path — and for promising to bring us all the way home. Help us to trust You even when we cannot see the road. We belong to You. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Family Action Item: As a family, take a walk together — even a short one — and while you walk, talk about where God has guided your family so far and where you trust He is taking you. End with a prayer of thanksgiving for the God who guides you home.
