**Baptism** is when a believer is immersed in water as a powerful witness of God's forgiveness of their sins, the end of their old life, and the beginning of their new life in Christ. Baptism is a commandment given by Christ and practiced by the apostles, the New Testament churches and Christians today.

It is an act of obedience. A response to what Christ has done for us. It is an external witness to those around us, and to the world, that there has been an internal work of salvation as we put our faith in Jesus Christ. The glory of baptism is that even though it is a physical act, it goes much deeper to reveal spiritual truths. Baptism is a symbol of the grave of the old sinful man and the resurrection of the new man in Christ. As we sink below the water, the believer buries all his corrupt affection and past sins. As he emerges, he is regenerated and quickened into a new and living hope. It symbolizes the shed blood of Christ and how His death redeemed us and opened a way to a new life in Christ.
