BIG IDEA

From the story of the Prodigal Son, Jesus teaches that it's often our righteous acts - even more than our sin - that prevents us from coming to God and receiving His grace.

What is God doing?

How is God at work in this passage?

Who am I?

Based on this passage, what do we learn about ourselves? What do we need to know about who we are in relationship to who God is and what He has done?

How should I live?

In light of what this passage tells us about God, what He has done, and who we are, how then should we live? What things do we need to repent of? What do we need to take to heart? Where do we need to trust God?
