God declares that the world, and therefore humanity is in darkness, that the world is the domain of darkness.

Humanity asserts that it is enlightened, and that its enlightenment is based on *faith* in human reason; *faith* in human reason we euphemistically refer to as rational objectivity.

1 Corinthians 15:17-19, 32b

And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins. Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. If in Christ we have hope in this life only, we are of all people most to be pitied...

If the dead are not raised, "Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die."
