





- Law of Non-Contradiction


## LOGICAL THINKING

# BIBLICAL GRACE

- Three Foundational Take-aways
  - Concepts are immaterial & private
  - Terms are either clear or unclear
  - Solve ambiguity with definitions

- Apprehension (Act)
- Terms (Logical Product)
- Word or Phrase (Linguistic Expression)
- What is it (Question Answered)
- Essence (Reveals)
- Clear i.e.unambiguous (Goal)
- Definition of terms (Methodology)
- What do you mean? (Practical Application)

### SECOND ACT OF THE MIND

- Judgment (Act)
- Propositions/Premises (Logical Product)
- Declarative Sentences (Linguistic Expression)
- Whether it is (Question Answered)
- Existence (Reveals)
- True (Goal)
- Various i.e. evidential, philosophical, anecdotal, etc.(Methodology)
- What is your point? (Practical Application)

### SECOND ACT OF THE MIND

- Judgment
- "Judging is more complex than apprehension. Instead of just thinking one concept, like 'man,' it relates two concepts, like "man" and "mortal" to each other by predicating one term (the predicate) of the other (the subject) in judging that, e.g., "Man is mortal" or "Man is not a triangle."

### SECOND ACT OF THE MIND

- Structural aspects of Judgment
- "A proposition has two structural parts: the subject term and the predicate term. The subject term is what you are talking about. The predicate term is what you say about the subject."

#### PREMISES

- Man is mortal.
- Man is not a triangle.
- Sushi is delicious.
- Fried bologna is yucky.
- North Idaho is a wild land.
- California is not a cool place.

#### PREMISES

- Declarative Sentence
  - Makes a truth claim
- Not an Interrogative sentence
  - Does not ask a question
- Not an Exclamatory sentence
  - Does not simply exclaim
- Not an Imperative sentence
  - Does not give a command

### PREMISES

- Answers the Question
  - Whether it is
- Reveals this aspect of Reality
  - Existence
- Overarching Goal
  - True Premises

- Practical Application
  - What is the point?
- Preferred Methodology
  - Contextual

  - Facts & Data to support.
- Philosophical
  - Evil exists.
  - Definitions and absolutes.
- Anecdotal
  - Sushi is amazingly delicious.
  - Taste it or recall prior experiences.

- Three Foundational Take-aways
  - Premises make a truth claim via a declarative sentence
  - Multitude of methods for verifying its veracity
  - A premise can only be true or false
