 Arabic Version- "The things written in the books could not be contained..."

• Syriac Version- "The world would not be sufficient for the books that should be written..."


• Persic Version- "... and the scribes of the world would fail or be deficient..."

• In other words all that Christ has done is far more than we can imagine.

## John Gill postulates...

- Not scribes enough in the world that they should write them.
- The world would be overloaded with them.
- The Holy Ghost would not lay such a burden upon man.
- The Holy Spirit gave us in this statement and in the Word itself all that we could manage...
- Only all that we could manage... Like...

#### Incarnation

- Incarnation- Act of being made flesh.
- Joh 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.
- This is the Christmas story... where we are at the time of this message.
- Mat 1:23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.

# Message of His Teaching


- The Reality of the Kingdom of God- "Repent for the Kingdom of God is at hand..."

### Obedience

- Rev 13:8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.
- The obedience of the cross is the greatest demonstration of obedience from God in the Flesh that need not surrender their authority.
- No greater demonstration of surrender than the one who had everything to surrender.



In other words, all that is necessary

To the salvation of mankind.

That is all just His Incarnation,

Miracles, Teachings, Obedience,

Resurrection and Ascension.
