Matthew 6:9-15

Mat 5:13-16 Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men. (14) Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. (15) Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. (16) Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.


The Lord's Prayer



- Formula, Road Map, or suggestion?
- Matt.6:9 After this manner therefore pray:
- Not lengthy, long, and filled with repetitive babbling concerned with the position of your body. But solely focused, concise and something like this...
- Grounded in the don't looking to the Do's

Our Father, which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

- 1. Our Father- πατήρ pater- metaphorically the originator and transmitter of anything. Author of a family unit.
 - 1. Reference to the person to who we are addressing, His character and attributes.
 - 2. Notice no references to Mary, or Saints, or supernatural powers or manifestations.
- 2. Which art in Heaven
 - 1. No mistaking which father we are referencing. Also, His location above all things.
- 3. Hallowed be thy name
 - 1. αγιάζω hagiazo- To make holy, this is an act of consecration not a title. Sanctify.

 - Submissive in that it yields ourselves to His unknown will.




Give us this day, our daily bread.




- Reminded of mana

 - Was replenished daily.
- All about understanding where your blessings come from and where your dependence should be placed.
 - Dependence on what we need for that day.
 - Dependence on what we need for tomorrow.

And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

- What debts do we owe a thrice Holy God?
 - Sin debt- The debt that none of us could have ever paid.
 - We are dependent upon Him and the shed blood of Jesus and the Spirits indwelling to pay that.
 - It is a daily reminder that we had a debt which we could not pay.
- This is why we should forgive.
 - No one ever deserves forgiveness
 - No one is ever owed forgiveness

- Lead us not into temptation
 - God's temptations- Not through sin but through hardship like Abraham and Issac and the sacrifice, or Job.

- But Deliver us
 - To rescue, to deliver because we invariably will find ourselves in it. Count it all joy... (James 1:2)




It is presumptive to think that is we are vengeful and spiteful filled with unforgiveness that we have the forgiveness of God at all within our lives that leads us to salvation.
