

- Historical Apologetics (3rd Level)

THEISM

- Definition
 - Theos
- A-theism
 - Law of non-contradiction
 - Agnosticism

THEISTIC PROOFS

Description

Philosophical proofs based upon observable reality

• Purpose

Corroborate general revelation

Limitations

• Provides a single element of divine truth

BIBLICAL EXAMPLE

- Apostle Paul at Aeropagus
- Acts 17:22-34

Cosmological Argument
Omnipotent Person
Teleological Argument
Omniscient Presence

- Moral Argument
 - Opulent Perfection
