


The Resurrection took place at a specific time, in a chosen place, to the Messiah.

Jesus, who is fully divine, fully human, and the Messiah.



How?

Jesus' resurrection as the first fruits, provides believers with the Holy Spirit, and ultimately, freedom from sin in the presence of God the Father.





When?

Jesus' resurrection culminates with the transformation of His children and concludes after death's eradication at the Great White Throne Judgment.

"Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does corruption inherit incorruption. Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed—in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality..."

"So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: 'Death is swallowed up in victory.'

"O Death, where is your sting? O Hades, where is your victory?"


The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law..."




BIBLICAL APPLICATION






