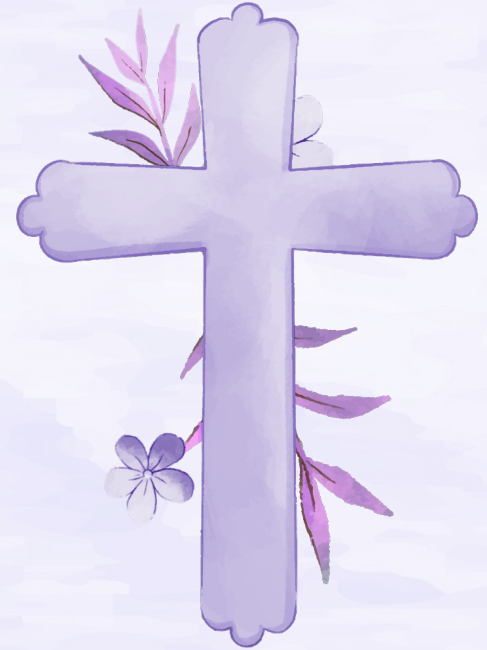

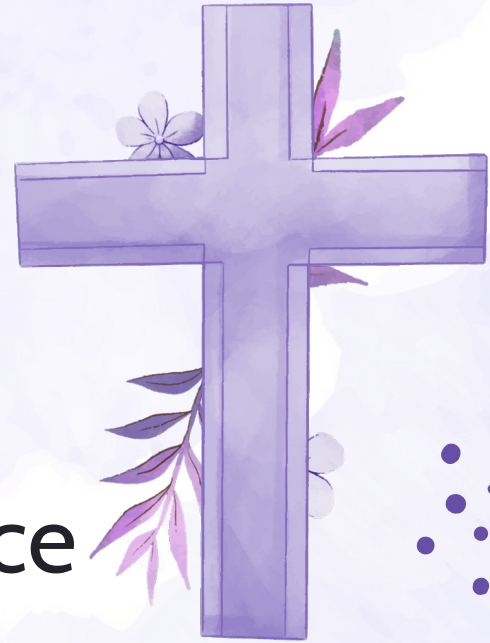

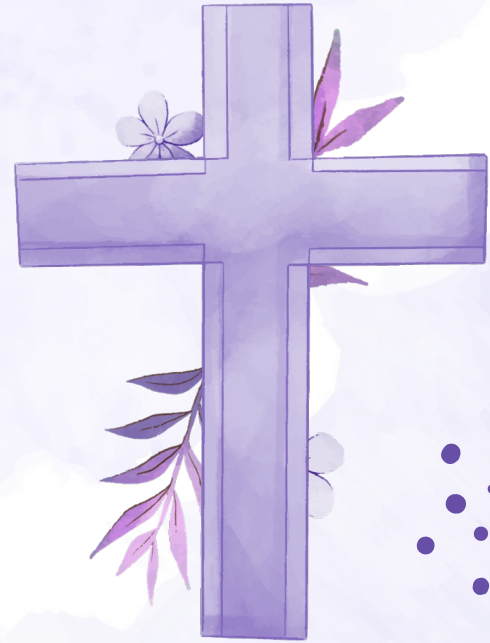
Why?

To glorify our God, by granting verifiable testimony to all, and grace for believing humanity.



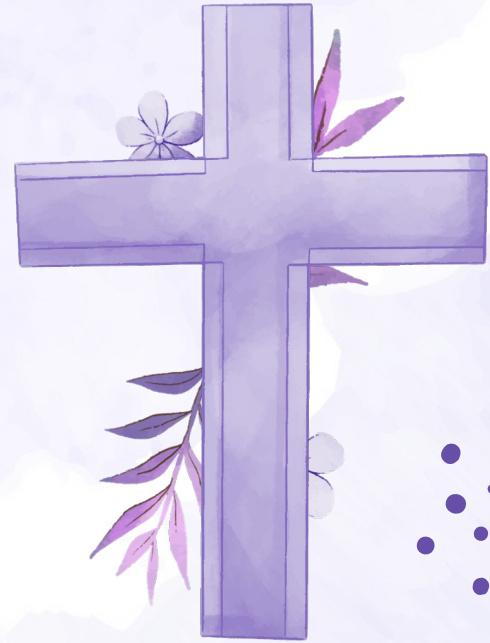
Where?

The resurrection of Jesus the Christ, grants salvation for believers in three stages: justification, sanctification, and glorification.

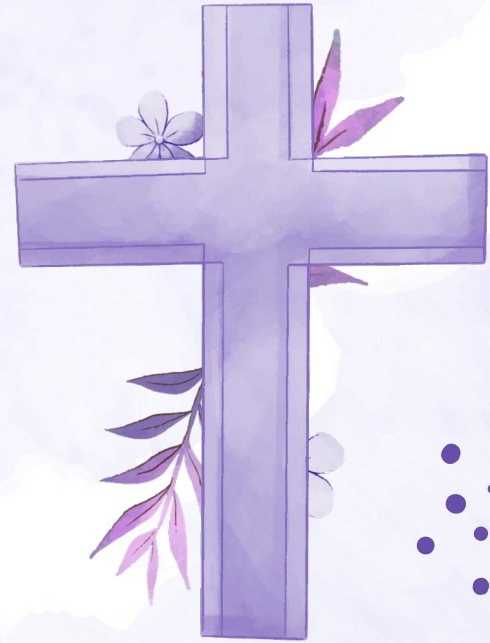


How?



Jesus' resurrection culminates with the transformation of His children and concludes after death's eradication at the Great White Throne Judgment.




