► Is unity

A – corporate affiliation without individual agreement

- ▶ B complete similarity in ritual and rationale
- C oneness of heart & heading based on a common interest

► Is unity

A – corporate affiliation without individual agreement (UNION i.e. Ecumenism)

B – complete similarity in ritual and rationale (UNIFORMITY i.e. Catholicism)

C – oneness of heart & heading based on a common interest (UNITY i.e. Body of Christ)

What is the Essential of the Christian Faith? THE GOSPEL

What at the essentials of the salvation aspect of the Gospel? ► God's Unity & Human Depravity Necessity of both Grace & Faith Christ's Deity & Humanity Christ's atoning death & resurrection ▶ Inspiration, Inerrancy, & Infallibility of the Bible

QUALIFIERS

Is repentance an Essential of the Christian Faith?

Necessary aspect of Genuine Saving Faith

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation" 2 Corinthians 5:17

"Therefore by their fruits you will know them" Matthew 7:20

QUALIFIERS

How can vital Christian Doctrine be labeled "non-essential"?

Context, i.e. salvation vs sanctification

"Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" 2 Timothy 2:15

QUALIFIERS

Are Presuppositionalist arrogant? Individually, no. ► Methodology, yes. ▶ 1 Peter 3:15..."with meekness & fear" Acts 17:17... "{Paul} reasoned in the synagogue with the Jews and with the Gentile worshipers"

#1 – COMPREHENSIVE
 Foundational nature of truth
 Fundamental doctrine of the Trinity

► #2 – CONTEXTUAL

- Starts with the opponent's worldview
- **ENGAGE**, explain, & exemplify

#3 – CAPABLE
 Nothing escapes its scope
 Engage, EXPLAIN, & Exemplify

#4 – CONVINCING
 Powerful, Persuasive, & Purposeful
 Engage, Explain, & EXEMPLIFY

#5 – CREDIBLE
 Valid Arguments
 Verifiable Evidence
 Veracious Philosophy

► #6 – CHALLENGING

- ► The Gospel of John Augustine
- "It is shallow enough for a child not to drown, yet deep enough for an elephant to swim in it."

► #7 – CONGRUENT

Divine Revelation Alignment

General Revelation – Romans 1:8-28

Special Revelation – Acts 17:10-13

GENERAL REVELATION "For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse, because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened. Professing to be wise, they became fools."

Romans 1:20-22

SPECIAL REVELATION "Then the brethren immediately sent Paul and Silas away by night to Berea. When they arrived, they went into the synagogue of the Jews. These were more fair-minded than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so. Therefore many of them believed"

Acts 17:10-12

#8 – CHRIST CENTERED
 Foundational Position (John 14:6)
 Focal Point (John 5:39)
 Final Purpose (John 3:16)

COMMON CONFUSION

 Two most common misperceptions:
 1 – Human Reasoning greater than Divine Revelation

► 2 – Usurpation of Holy Spirit's role in Salvation

METHODOLOGY (TOC)

Norman Geisler's 12 Points

- Truth about reality is knowable

- ▶ It is true that the theistic God exists
- ▶ If God exists then miracles are possible
- Miracles can be used to confirm a message from God
