LETTER FROM BUCK

We began 2023 with a call from the Scriptures to "Praise the Lord, all nations", and in that desire, we have experienced а historical vear in CrossPoint Missions. For the first time in our history, we invited all of our international mission partners to join us here at CrossPoint during our Mission Expo in January. During those four nights, the Spirit of the Lord was palpable, and we grew in our gospel partnership in ways beyond what we could have imagined.



With this as our spring board, we went out into the nations, sending 220 CrossPointers into 10 countries across 4 continents. We sent 2 CrossPointers on mid-term assignments in Romania and Guatemala. We continued to celebrate the opportunities that the Lord has graciously provided by hosting our first ever Missions Commissioning Cookout. We gave generously to the Missions Stream, setting a new record for annual giving. It was truly a historic year, and we thank the Lord alone for it! As we look to 2024, we continue to seek to praise the Lord among all nations! Here at CrossPoint, our desire is to take the message and love of Christ HERE, THERE, & EVERYWHERE. During our 2024 Expo, we want to specifically highlight the opportunities that the Lord has provided for us to serve Him HERE, in our local community, through our local mission partnerships. In January, we will celebrate these partnerships. We will hear from them, meet them, and serve In fact, we want with them. all CrossPointers to serve somewhere during the month of January. We want you to engage with one of our local mission partners, or allow the Lord to lead you to serve our community in a new way.

Our theme for this year's Expo is "Created for Good Works" from Ephesians 2:10. We have always said that, here at CrossPoint, we are "Saved to Serve". Our theme verse makes it clear that, as a child of God, you were actually created in Christ to serve. The Lord has prepared good works for you to perform. He has equipped you with gifts, talents, and passions. I encourage you to seek the Lord this January and ask Him to reveal where He wants you to serve HERE in our community. Step out of your comfort zone. See how the Lord will use you. You were created for His purposes!

Vision of CrossPoint Missions

In accordance with the vision of CrossPoint, the purpose of CrossPoint Missions is to reach **JUST ONE MORE** by partnering with gospel-centered ministries HERE, THERE & EVERYWHERE in sharing the message and love of Jesus Christ.

CrossPoint Missions is grounded in these Biblical convictions:

1. <u>The ultimate goal of missions is the eternal</u> <u>glorification of God by all people groups on earth.</u>

2023 Missions Year In Review

- 220 CrossPointers traveled internationally or domestically on short-term mission trips to 10 countries on 4 continents.
- CrossPoint commissioned Laura Claire Bollinger and Anna Satterfield for mid-term mission assignments in **Romania** and **Guatemala**.
- CrossPoint supported international church plants in **Germany**, **Peru** and **Canada** and domestic church plants in **Atlanta**, **Mobile**, **Gurley** (AL) and **Oneonta** (AL).
- 163 CrossPoint students participated in a community serve day in February. An additional 50 students participated in a mission day in June with various ministries, including The Wellhouse, Serving You Ministries, Brother Bryan Ministry and Peachtree Senior Living.
- CrossPoint hosted/sponsored events with local mission partners, including the 2nd annual **Guidelight Retreat**, the Designed for More banquet for **Decisions**, **Choices & Options**, and a build day with **Sleep in Heavenly Peace**.
- CrossPoint hosted **10** international mission partners for the 2023 Missions Expo in January.
- CrossPointers packed **1,312 Operation Christmas Child** shoeboxes and collected a total of **2,736** shoeboxes serving as an area collection site.
- CrossPoint hosted its 1st annual Missions Commissioning Cookout in June.
- CrossPointers gave **over \$420,000** to the Missions Stream, a record year (breakdown below).

At CrossPoint, we seek to serve the Lord through a missional approach to ministry. In other words, we look outward instead of inward. This is reflected in our giving, as mission endeavors are funded through all three streams of CrossPoint's river of stewardship: Ministry Stream, Manna Stream, and **Missions Stream**.

Through God's provision and your generosity, since becoming debt-free, we have been able to invest over **\$2.3 million** in missions and ministries around the globe. While we are missional with our Ministry and Manna Streams, the **Missions Stream** is 100% dedicated to sharing God's message and love around the world. In 2023, you gave over **\$420,000** for the **Missions Stream** - the highest total given to this stream in CrossPoint's history! Praise God from whom all blessings flow!

GOAL FOR 2024

In 2024, amounts given to the Missions Stream will be allocated: **40%** to the International Mission Board's Lottie Moon Offering, **20%** to the North American Mission Board's Annie Armstrong Offering, and **40%** to CrossPoint Direct Missions. CrossPoint Direct Missions giving has been utilized historically to provide support to our direct mission partners, supplement mission trip costs through scholarships and meet needs and opportunities that arise related to our various mission endeavors. It is truly amazing to see what God is doing through your generosity to the **Missions Stream**.

What an opportunity we have as a church family, and what an opportunity you have as an individual or as a family to join God where He is working at home and around the world! Pray about what God would have you give to Missions in 2024!

The opportunities to engage with our Mission Partners face-to-face, to encourage them, and to serve alongside them are ever-expanding. Many of you have had the blessing of going on mission for the sake of the gospel. Others are curious but are not sure where to begin.

Here are several ways to GO on mission:

Short-Term Mission Team Leader:

The Leader has been actively involved in missions historically and feels led to take on a leadership role with one of our existing mission teams or to lead a new mission endeavor. The Leader's primary responsibility is to disciple and to pray for those on your mission team. The Leader is also responsible for recruiting and training team members, working with the Minister of Missions and Mission Partner to finalize trip logistics, preparing the team for the trip, supervising the team while on the field, ensuring the financial responsibilities of the team are met and documented, and reporting on the trip upon the team's return.

Short-Term Mission Team Member:

The Member may or may not have missions experience, but acknowledges the Biblical calling to take the gospel to the nations. *Team Members are expected to prayerfully seek to live out their CrossPoint Membership Covenant while on mission.*

Mission Point Partner:

Point Partners actively support CrossPoint's Mission Partners and Short-Term Mission Teams through prayer and encouragement. *Mission Point Partners are responsible for maintaining regular contact with our Mission Partners and actively encouraging them through cards, notes, emails, etc.*



In the gospel, Jesus calls believers to love and care for one another, particularly those facing challenges and burdens. The retreat becomes a space where the church actively shares in the challenges faced by families affected by disability. The gospel-centered nature of the retreat is evident in its intentional design to meet the unique needs of the families. Each child is paired with a buddy (or two) for the weekend. Buddies are prepped with key details, provided by the families, that will create the safest and best experience for the child and the buddy. While the children participate in a structured program with lessons. activities, crafts and free play, the parents are connecting with each other. worshiping, and learning through sessions led by speakers who have been impacted by disability.



As the weekend progresses, it is beautiful to see how the Lord allows these families to form new friendships, learn from the wisdom of experiences, and be among others who truly understand the journey. The retreat serves as a tangible experience where families can witness the presence of Jesus amid their challenges.



The volunteers, driven by a passion to serve, come away from this retreat deeply impacted by the relationships and bonds formed with the children and families. The gospel is not just proclaimed but lived out in the actions of those who serve at the retreat, creating a transformative experience for both the families and the church volunteers.



In sponsoring a retreat that is explicitly gospel-centered, CrossPoint becomes an extension of Jesus' ministry, offering a place of healing, renewal, and hope. The retreat serves as a reminder that, in the face of seemingly relentless challenges, Jesus is present, walking alongside families affected by disability.

Zona Zegura Ministries is a network of house churches that minister among the Andes Mountains in and around Cusco, Peru. Throughout the year, Zona Zegura trains and equips local pastors, who shepherd these house churches. Zona Zegura also operates an orphanage in Cachora, Peru, which houses dozens of children. In recent years, Zona sent its own missionaries to Lima and Arequipa, Peru to plant house churches in those regions.


Mission:






