Don't get scammed! Pastor Fran will NEVER text you or email you about buying gift cards or spending your money for the church. Any requests of that kind are coming from "fake" email addresses and phone numbers that are not Fran's. When you get a message from Fran, be sure to read the email or phone number carefully. Fran's email is francooper@vaumc.org ONLY.

Fran's phone number is (757) 630-7412 ONLY.

If you are ever unsure about a request made by Fran, message her through the above means to verify that the request is authentic. Pastor Fran cannot stop these scam emails from happening; people are using her name and title to scam others. The people who do this are crafty, so beware!

This part-time, hourly position requires about 6-8 hours a week, including Mondays, from 9-11am and other flex hours for completion of weekly work. Duties include: documenting all church gifts and revenues; scheduling and managing a team of volunteers who count and record all physically received income; posting giving through our church giving software and computer systems; providing special reports and information to church staff and committees; protecting the confidentiality of the donors; answering donor inquiries and consulting with potential donors regarding contribution methods; and supporting the Stewardship and Capital campaigns, memorial, endowment, and special contribution funds. The Financial Secretary reports to the Lead Pastor and Staff-Parish Relations Committee, works closely with the Church Bookkeeper and Church Treasurer, and consults and reports with the Finance Committee.
