

Electronic Giving:

We accept Electronic Funds Transfers (EFT). Many families are doing this to help budget monthly, ease of giving each month, and reduce cost to the Church. You can do this through your online banking system in the same way you pay your bills online. You would log into your own banking system and go to the Pay Bills/Electronic Payment section. Enter Larchmont UMC (1101 Jamestown Crescent Norfolk VA 23508) as a new payee and set up your giving schedule (weekly/monthly/quarterly) and the amount. On the Memo Line please indicate Pledge/Tithe. Your bank will send us a check based on your instructions in the set up.

This way you are doing the giving and can adjust it at any time you wish.

End of Year Giving

Please note IRS rules require any contributions recorded as given in 2023 must be received by the church by the close of business December 31, 2023. Any donations/gifts of stock/IRA contributions made to the Church must be received by the Church no later than December 28th for 2023 tax credit. Equities transferred through a brokerage are considered delivered when they are transferred on the books of the corporation. Contributions sent through the mail are considered delivered on the date of the postmark. Postings to the church=s financial records will reflect these rules. Please consider giving your yearly tithe to the church by Christmas so that we may fulfill our commitments for the 2023 Year.

Gifts of Stock or IRA Contributions to the Church

If you wish to give a gift of stocks or shares to Larchmont Church, please do the following:

- Have your Broker contact Sammy Serafine at Wells Fargo Securities Ph: 757 431-6312
- Wells Fargo Securities will sell the stock and forward a check to the Church.
- Upon verification of donor, distribution of funds will be posted to your account.
- If your Broker is with Wells Fargo Securities, please use the Church=s account number which is 4952-4700

Important Reminder:

Each year someone will wait until Dec. 31st to transfer their stocks to LUMC but due to the Holidays, the transaction does not post until the New Year. This means you do not get credit for it in the current year. Please consider making any Stock Transactions prior to Christmas Day to prevent a loss of a Contribution Donation for your 2023 Taxes. Also, please contact Lynn and let her know that you are sending Stock so that she can properly post the Contribution.

The flowers will be placed in the chancel area on Dec. 17th. You are welcome to take your flower home after the Christmas Eve service.


