Build for the Future Sanctuary Renovation Update!

Some of you may have noticed the conspicuous hole in the Sanctuary NARTHEX ceiling. If not, check it out! Church members on the Build for the Future Task Force recently made that DIY cost-saving opening for a structural engineer working with our architectural firm. Those exposed joists and metal beam have not been seen since 1952. The late-great author Maya Angelo said: "You can't really know where you're going, unless you know where you've been." So true.

Making that small inspection access cut took four people and 2-3 saw blades over two strenuous hours for a reason - those who came before us did a great job planning and building a sound structure for the future, and we are following their lead. Our Architects are working with the structural engineer and when they are ready to share draft sketches with the congregation, we'll schedule opportunities to get your input.

Lastly, the next time you step into the NARTHEX, look up and let your imagination take you into the future. See the smiles at the ribbon-cutting, hear the special music and ceremonial prayer, feel the hugs and handshakes, and imagine your first look at a glorious sanctuary ready for God's plan. You'll be so glad you were a part of this moment in the life of our wonderful church. It's okay. Go ahead... get excited.
