There has been a large increase in households and individuals seeking assistance from our Food Locker. During the summer month, we assisted an average of 12 households and 43 individuals per month. In September, the numbers doubled to 24 households and 76 individuals, and the number of bags given out tripled to 69. In October, we are on track to exceed the September numbers.

Assuming demand will continue to be high during the winter months, we need additional cash contributions to meet expected demand. 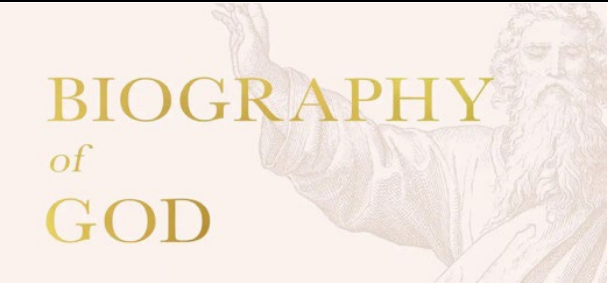
LUMC Grounds Cleanup!
