LUMC Missions committee has a new partnership with James Monroe Elementary School.

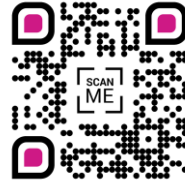
We are excited to host an End-of-Term Ice Cream Social with the summer school children and parents as an outside event at the school.
