

Please note IRS rules require any contributions recorded as given in 2023 must be received by the church by the close of business December 31, 2023. Any <u>donations/gifts of</u> <u>stock/IRA contributions</u> made to the Church must be received by the Church no later than December 28<sup>th</sup> for 2023 tax credit. Equities transferred through a brokerage are considered delivered when they are transferred on the books of the corporation. Contributions sent through the mail are considered delivered on the date of the postmark. Postings to the church=s financial records will reflect these rules. **Please consider giving your yearly tithe to the church by Christmas so that we may fulfill our commitments for the 2023 Year.** 

#### Gifts of Stock or IRA Contributions to the Church

If you wish to give a gift of stocks or shares to Larchmont Church, please do the following:

- Wells Fargo Securities will sell the stock and forward a check to the Church.
- Upon verification of donor, distribution of funds will be posted to your account.
- If your Broker is with Wells Fargo Securities, please use the Church=s account number which is 4952-4700.
