graciously give us all things?" (Romans 8:32)

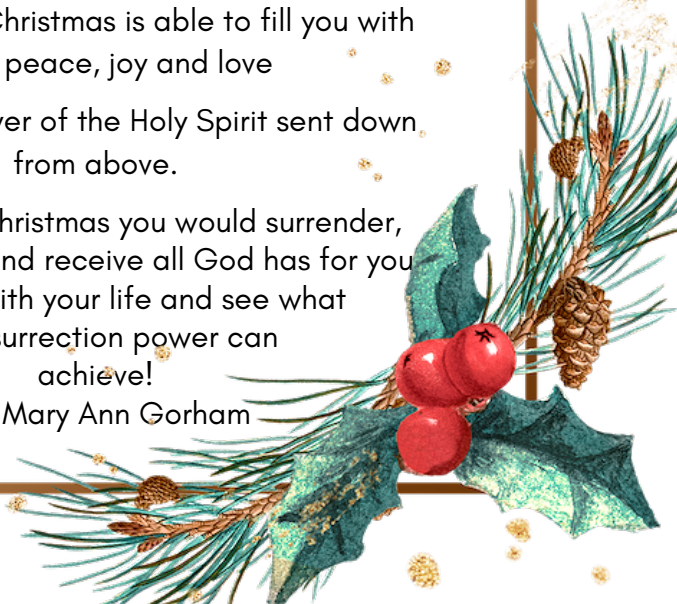
All glory and honor to our holy, merciful Father and
