DAVID'S ANOINTING:

Saul is	God <u>SELECTS</u> a	Samuel looks at	God looks at the	David is <u>FOUND</u>	David is

THE IRONY OF WHAT HAPPENS NEXT:

- The Spirit <u>DEPARTS</u> from Saul and <u>COMES UPON</u> David.
- The anointed King <u>SERVES</u> the rejected King.
- The rejected King <u>LOVES</u> the anointed King.
- The reject King <u>APPOINTS</u> the anointed King as <u>ARMOR BEARER</u>.
- The anointed King <u>CARES</u> for the rejected King.

DAVID'S IMPRESSIVE RESUME:

- 1. David was a <u>SKILLFUL MUSICIAN</u>...are you <u>USING</u> your <u>GIFTS</u>?
- 2. David was a <u>MIGHTY MAN</u> of valor...are you <u>BOLD</u> in your <u>FAITH</u>?
- 3. David was <u>PRUDENT</u> in <u>SPEECH</u>...are your <u>WORDS</u> flavored with <u>GRACE</u>?
- 4. David was a <u>HANDSOME MAN</u>...are you <u>CARING</u> for your <u>BODY</u>?
- 5. David had the <u>LORD</u> with him...are you <u>WALKING</u> with <u>JESUS</u>?

SEEING THE GOSPEL REALITIES:

- The Gospel <u>RESCUES</u> us but doesn't <u>RECUSE</u> us.
- The Gospel <u>GIFTS</u> us for His <u>GLORY</u>.
- The Gospel <u>SAVES</u> us but also <u>SUSTAINS</u> us.

BOTTOM LINE:

David's HUMILITY, not his HEAD, grew as GOD'S PLAN progressed.
