  - c. DAVID is ANNOINTED KING.
    - i. Man looks at OUTWARD appearance.
    - ii. God looks at the HEART.
    - iii. David was a MAN after God's HEART.
2. David's TRAINING
  - a. 15 YEARS of training
  - b. Outer ENEMY

- i. GOLIATH (1 Samuel 17)
    - ii. Fleeing from SAUL
  - c. Inner ENEMY
    - i. Temptation to KILL Saul (1 Samuel 24)
    - ii. Fleeing to the PHILISTINES
  - d. David was a SINNER...the God CHOSE to USE!
  - e. A look at David's CHARACTER.

3. David as KING
- a. First, anointed King of JUDAH for 7 ½ years. (2 Samuel 2:4)
  - b. Then, anointed King of ISRAEL for 33 ½ years. (2 Samuel 5)
  - c. David brings the ARK back to JERUSALEM.
4. THE PROMISE is RENEWED!
- a. We are FINALLY seeing the GREAT NATION become a REALITY!
  - b. The LAND is GROWING.
  - c. David is a GOOD KING.
  - d. A look at David's CHARACTER.
