1 CORINTHIANS 13:4b

LOVE FROM 1 CORINTHIANS 13

- 1. LOVE is perfectly DEFINED and PERSONIFIED by God's ACTIVITY in the GOSPEL.
- **2.** True LOVE is only the result of the HOLY SPIRIT'S presence in the life of the CHRISTIAN.
- 3. LOVE is not the end goal \rightarrow it is a vehicle used to GLORIFY God and BUILD up the CHURCH.
- 4. MAN is neither the CREATOR, nor the CULTIVATOR of LOVE in his own life, and thus, WE do not get to determine whom we LOVE.

KEY DEFINITIONS

- LOVE does not ENVY.
 - o Defined: Acting out on what we DO NOT have.
 - o Practiced: We WANT what others HAVE and don't WANT them to HAVE the things we DON'T.
- LOVE does not BOAST.
 - o Defined: Acting out on what we HAVE been GIVEN.
 - o *Practiced*: We CELEBRATE ourselves by BRINGING others DOWN.

CASE STUDIES

- LOVE does not ENVY.
 - o NEGATIVE: Solomon and the mothers (1 Kings 3:16-27)
 - o POSITIVE: Jonathan and David (1 Samuel 20:1-17)
- LOVE does not BOAST.
 - NEGATIVE: Nebuchadnezzar brought low (Daniel 4:28-33)
 - O POSITIVE: Jesus humbles Himself (Philippians 2:1-11)

LOVE IN ACTION

- 1. STOP comparing and START celebrating!
- 2. REMEMBER your condition and REJOICE in the CROSS.

LOVING WITH YOUR LIFE: 1 CORINTHIANS 13:4-8
