David <u>RECOGNIZES</u> his <u>SIN NATURE</u> .	Do you?

RECOGNIZING THE CHARACTER OF GOD

- God is UNFAILING in His LOVE.
- God is COMPASSIONATE and MERCIFUL.
- God is BLAMELESS and JUST.
- God is GRACIOUS and RIGHTEOUS.

RESPONDING TO OUR SIN AND GOD’S CHARACTER

- We must CONFESS our SIN.
- We must REPENT of our SIN.
- We must BELIEVE God RESTORES.
- We must PRAISE God for SALVATION.
