• DO NOT WORRY.

FIVE REASONS WHY (Matthew 6:25-32)

- 1. Life is too important.
- 2. You are too important.
- 3. It doesn't do any good.
- 4. God cares about you.
- 5. We have no reason.

FOLLOWING THIS COMMAND (Matthew 6:33-34)

- Replace our worried searching with a righteous seeking.
- Replace our future concern with present contentment.

WHERE DO WE SEARCH?
