1 CORINTHIANS 13:4b

KEY DEFINITIONS

- LOVE is not ARROGANT.
 - Arrogance Defined: a SENSE of SUPERIORITY.
 - *True Love Defined:* KNOWING all THINGS come FROM God and are FOR God.
 - o Arrogance Practiced: We MAKE ourselves BETTER than everyone ELSE.
 - True Love Practiced: We MAKE others MORE IMPORTANT than OURSELVES.
- LOVE is not RUDE.
 - Rude Defined: an ATTITUDE of CARELESSNESS.
 - True Love Defined: KNOWING and EXTENDING the GRACE we have been SHOWN in Christ.
 - Rude Practiced: We CARE about our NEEDS being MET.
 - *True Love Practiced:* We CARE about meeting the NEEDS of OTHERS.

CASE STUDIES

- I. LOVE that is not ARROGANT is a LOVE that is HUMBLE. (John 3:27-30)
 - People that have a HUMBLE love know EXACTLY who they ARE.
 - People that have a HUMBLE love have an UNDENIABLE PURPOSE.
 - People that have a HUMBLE love find JOY in OTHERS.
 - People that have a HUMBLE love live OTHERS MINDED.
- 2. LOVE that is not RUDE is a LOVE that is CONSIDERATE. (Luke 7:36-46)
 - People that have a CONSIDERATE love withhold JUDGMENT of others.
 - People that have a CONSIDERATE love understand GRACE.
 - People that have a CONSIDERATE love care for OTHERS NEEDS.
