
# PROGRESS OF REDEMPTION: ACT ONE, SCENE TWO, STEPS 1-3.

### REVIEW

- Good News: The <u>GREAT NATION</u> is finally a <u>REALITY</u>.
- Bad News: The <u>GREAT NATION</u> is beginning to <u>DISSOLVE</u>.
- Solomon's <u>SIN</u> causes <u>ISRAEL</u> to be <u>CUT-OFF</u>. (1 Kings 11:1-13)
  - Negative Results:
    - 2 Kings 23:13 (300 years later!)
    - Nehemiah 13:25-26 (500 years later!)
- The <u>GREAT NATION</u> reaches the point of <u>CIVIL WAR</u>. (1 Kings 12:1-24)
- God tells them this is <u>HIS DOING</u>. (1 Kings 12:24)

# SCENE ONE, ACT TWO, STEP 1: A DIVIDED KINGDOM (JUDAH & ISRAEL)

1. Israel <u>SPLITS</u> from <u>JUDAH</u>



- a. Israel
  - i. <u>10</u> tribes
  - ii. <u>211</u> years
  - iii. <u>19</u> kings (all <u>BAD</u>)
- b. Judah
  - i. <u>2</u> tribes
  - ii. <u>347</u> years
  - iii. <u>20</u> kings (12 <u>BAD</u>, 4 <u>GOOD</u>, 4 <u>OK</u>)

- c. War and Peace
  - i. Began war and conflict
  - ii. Then peace and alliance
  - iii. But war and conflict again
  - iv. Then peace and prosperity
  - v. War–Judah vs. Israel and Syria
- b. <u>RELIGIOUS</u> Invasion
  - i. BAAL WORSHIP
  - ii. Two Key Figures: ELIJAH and ELISHA (1 Kings 17-2 Kings 8)
  - iii. The <u>NATION</u> was a <u>MESS</u>. (2 Kings 17:14-17)

#### SCENE ONE, ACT TWO, STEPS 2-3:

THE ASSYRIAN CRISIS (ISRAEL DESTROYED); THE BABYLONIAN CRISIS (JUDAH IN CAPTIVITY)

- 1. <u>ISRAEL</u> is <u>EXILED</u> by the <u>ASSYRIAN</u> Empire.
- 2. JUDAH is <u>CAPTURED</u> by the <u>BABYLONIAN</u> Empire.
  - a. <u>70 AWFUL</u> years.
  - b. The <u>GREAT NATION</u> is in <u>BIG TROUBLE</u>.
- 3. Hope: God will <u>RESTORE</u>! (Jeremiah 29:10-14)

## BOTTOM LINE: BE <u>PAITENT</u> BECAUSE <u>GOD</u> IS NOT IN A <u>HURRY</u>!
