#### WHAT WE KNOW

#### SEVEN SCENES OF THE STORY

- **SCENE 1:** Joseph as a dream.
- **SCENE 2:** Joseph sold into slavery.
- SCENE 3: Joseph rises to power in Potiphar's house and is falsely accused of rape.
- SCENE 4: Joseph thrown in jail, interprets dreams, and is forgotten.
- **SCENE 5:** Joseph interprets Pharaoh's dream about plenty and famine.
- SCENE 6: Joseph placed in power in Egypt and administers dealing with plenty and famine.
- **SCENE 7:** Joseph deals with his brothers who need help.

# THE PURPOSE OF JOSEPH'S STORY

- **SEEING THE PURPOSE:** God sent Joseph on a mission to preserve life.
- **SEEING OUR GOOD:** God brought Joseph's family to Goshen to multiply in the land of plenty.
- **SEEING HIS GLORY:** God multiplied Joseph's family to become a nation through which Jesus came to redeem His people!

### THE PURPOSE OF JOSEPH'S STORY

- **SEEING THE PURPOSE:** God sends us on mission to preserve life.
- **SEEING OUR GOOD:** God is shaping us into the image of Jesus. (Romans 8:28-29)
- **SEEING HIS GLORY:** God is making His name great through us. (Ephesians 2:10)
