#### PROGRESS OF REDEMPTION

- We will focus primarily on RELATIONSHIP not CONTENT.
- We will focus primarily on the <u>PROGRESS</u> and <u>UNITY</u> of these <u>RELATIONSHIPS</u> in what God is DOING.
  - o Is the Bible one book?
  - $\circ$  Is the Bible two books (OT/NT)?
  - o Is the Bible 66 books?

#### **DEFINING UNITY AND PROGRESS**
