II. When Unbelief Gets Ugly

Skeptic – Questions accepted opinions/beliefs...with fear clouding judgment.

Cynic – Other people are motivated by self-interest...with apathy and criticism.

Rebel – Resists authority or cultural norms...because they don't want it to be true.

IV. We can have what we *really* want by beginning to believe (John 20:29)
